Swim Lessons

Swim lessons are available for members (\$60) and non-members (\$80). The lessons are 25 minutes each day and will run for 9 days between the hours of 10-12, changing to 9-11 mid July. Our average class size is 4-6 per class and the levels are listed at the pool. If you are uncertain of the level your child should be placed in you can contact one of our swim instructors by calling the pool; we will then schedule an assessment. Registration begins Memorial Day weekend in the pool office and payment is due at registration. We do our best to schedule siblings as close to the same time as possible. Treasurer's Report

Thank you to everyone who has paid their dues, especially those III homeowners who have already paid in full for the year! At the end of the first quarter, we collected 48% of budgeted dues for the year and our combined cash and securities are sufficient, totaling \$282,332.84. We are prepared financially for summer when most of our expenses are incurred.

A reminder about delinquent dues: If dues are more than one quarter past due, a late fee of \$5 will be charged. If more than one year past due, a finance fee of 10% per year will be assessed in addition to the late fee. Dues must be current to enjoy the pool.

Being In Compliance

The definition of the word 'comply' is "to conform, submit, or adapt (as to a regulation or to another's wishes) as required or requested" according to the Merriam-Webster dictionary. When each and every one of us decided to purchase or live in the Kingsgate V neighborhood, we all agreed to abide by or comply with the By-Laws and/or the Conditions, Covenants, and Restrictions (CCR's) of our neighborhood. Your Kingsgate V board is in charge of enforcing the rules and regulations stipulated in these two documents. A few weeks ago, a subcommittee of the board toured the neighborhood and took notes on various compliance issues. The vast majority of the neighborhood is compliant with all aspects of owning a home in our community. However, there were a few areas that need work.

In our tour of the neighborhood, we observed fourteen different violations. The top issues that we noted:

- Too many vehicles Four vehicles can be kept at the residence, as long as they are legally licensed and in working order. Each vehicle must be parked legally on a paved driveway.
- **Visible debris or rubbish** No lot within the neighborhood shall be used as a dump of any kind. All garbage shall be kept in approved sanitary bins.
- **Boats, trailers and/or RV's** The preceding items must be stored behind a 6 foot fence, with height and length restrictions. Only one per residence.
- Evidence that multiple families Each lot has one single-family dwelling for single-family occupancy.
- Yard and/or shrubs are grossly overgrown No plantings or shrubs shall encroach on any sidewalk/street.
- Evidence of a business There are heavy restrictions on operating any kind of business out of the home.
- **Unfinished exterior construction –** There is a 9 month timeframe for any type of exterior construction to be completed.
- **Livestock** No livestock or breeding can be conducted on any lot.

As a board, we have made a decision to start enforcing our By-Laws and CCR's. We are on the verge of hiring an attorney to review our official documents to see if anything can be streamlined or an improvement of our procedures can be implemented.

Like I said before, the vast majorities of homeowners are in compliance and have nothing to worry about. For the rest, please review the CCR's. We are willing to work with you to resolve the issue. This is something that the board doesn't necessarily enjoy doing, but with rising property values and our neighborhood remaining very attractive to prospective buyers, we want to make sure that Kingsgate V remains that way.

Spring Home Maintenance Tips

- 1. Vacuum the lint from the hose of your clothes dryer.
- 2. Clean windows and repair any ripped screens. If a screen has a large hole in it, it's time to replace it.
- 3. Check gutters for clogs. Clean out any debris and make sure gutters and downspouts are secure.
- 4. Check the ground around the foundation of your house and re-grade it if necessary.
- 5. Test any GFCI outlets: plug in a lamp, hit the test button and then the reset button to see if it turns the light off and then on again.
- 6. Check for cracks in asphalt or concrete driveways and walkways. Repair or reseal them before winter, when water can freeze and expand in the cracks, creating more damage.
- 7. Check trees around the house to make sure they're not threatening wires or power lines. If they are, call a tree service to safely trim back branches.



We have 2 certified lifeguards on duty at all times.

No one under the age of 7 will be allowed in the deep end without an adult. A swim test will be given to all other young swimmers before being allowed in the deep end. Children who are 9 and older and have passed the swim test may come to he pool by themselves. Artificial swimming aids are only allowed in the pool when accompanied by an adult.
